These have been called the "be-attitudes."
Christ is teaching what it means to care about what God thinks, and how to experience God through a life of dedication.
He makes it clear that we must come to God in humility and belief. If we are hungry for God's truth in our lives, we are told we will

be satisfied.

Imagine if you could see life 100% from a spiritual perspective. This is what it would look like!

Jesus teaches that those who choose to follow God are like salt and light in a world that is rotting in darkness. The Gospel is the only hope for a man's soul.

The Scribes and Pharisees were influential leaders among the Jews. Jesus immediately

HEART TEACHINGS: GOD'S PERSPECTIVE ON A BLESSED LIFE

Matthew 5:1-48

When Jesus saw the huge crowds, He went up on the mountain; and after He sat down, His disciples came to Him. He began to teach them, saying,

"Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

Blessed are those who mourn, for they shall be comforted. Blessed are the gentle, for they shall inherit the earth.

Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they shall be satisfied.

Blessed are the merciful, for they shall receive mercy.
Blessed are the pure in heart, for they shall see God.
Blessed are the peacemakers, for they shall be called sons of God.

Blessed are those who have been persecuted for the sake of righteousness, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

Blessed are you when men throw insults at you, and persecute you, and say all kinds of evil against you falsely, on account of Me.

Rejoice, and be glad, for your reward in heaven is great, for so they persecuted the prophets who were before you.

You are the salt of the earth; but if the salt has become asteless, how will it be made salty again? It is good for nothing anymore, except to be thrown out and trampled under foot by men.

You are the light of the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hidden. Nor do men light a lamp, and put it under the bushel basket, but on the lamp stand; and it gives light to all who are in the house.

Let your light shine before men in such a way that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father who is in heaven.

Do not think that I came to abolish the Law or the Prophets; I did not come to abolish, but to fulfill.

For truly I say to you, until heaven and earth pass away, not the smallest letter or stroke shall pass away from the Law, until all is accomplished.

Whoever then negates one of the least of these commandments, and teaches others to do the same, shall be called least in the The requirements of God's Law were fulfilled by Christ. The Law reveals sin, sin brings death, and Christ conquered death through His submission to the will of His Father. Christ does what is necessary to fulfill the requirements of God's Law: the spilling of blood to pay for sin.



Read Exodus 20 and Deuteronomy 10

Here are a series of clarifying declarations of what the Law given to Moses was always supposed to mean to the heart-follower of the Living God. Christ's standards were much purer than those which the

"You have heard that the ancients were told, 'You shall not commit murder' and 'Whoever commits murder shall be liable to the court.' But I say to you that everyone who is angry with his brother shall be guilty before the court; and whoever shall say to his brother, 'Raca,' shall be guilty before the supreme court; and whoever shall say, 'You fool,' shall be guilty enough to go into the fiery hell.

"If you are presenting your offering at the altar, and there remember that your brother has something against you, leave your offering there before the altar, and go your way; first be reconciled to your brother, and then come and present your offering. Make friends quickly with your opponent at law while you are with him on the way, in order that your opponent may not deliver you to the judge, and the judge to the officer, and you be thrown into prison. Truly I say to you, you shall not come out of there, until you have paid the last cent.

"You have heard that it was said, 'You shall not commit adultery'; but I say to you, that everyone who looks on a woman to lust for her has committed adultery with her already in his heart. And if your right eye makes you stumble, tear it out, and throw it from you; for it is better for you that one of the parts of your body perish, than for your whole body to be thrown into hell. And if your right hand makes you stumble, cut it off, and throw it from you; for it is better for you that one of the parts of your body perish, than for your whole body to go into hell.

"And it was said, 'Whoever sends his wife away, let him give her a certificate of divorce'; but I say to you that everyone who divorces his wife, except for the cause of moral impurity, makes her commit adultery; and whoever marries a divorced woman commits adultery.

"Again, you have heard that the ancients were told, 'You shall not make false vows, but shall fulfill your vows to the Lord.' But I say to you, make no oath at all, either by heaven, for it is the throne of God, or by the earth, for it is the footstool of His feet, or by Jerusalem, for it is the city of the great King. Nor shall you make an oath by your head, for you cannot make one hair white or black. But let your statement be, 'Yes, yes' or 'No, no; and anything beyond this is evil.

"You have heard that it was said, 'An eye for an eye, and a tooth for a tooth.' But I say to you, do not resist him who is evil; but whoever slaps you on your right cheek, turn to him the other also.

"And if anyone wants to sue you, and take your shirt, let him have your coat as well. And whoever shall force you to go one mile, go with him two. Give to him who asks of you, and do


